Information and Guidelines:

We are interested in concept ideas that are unique; avoiding cliches, such as Darwin's beard, for example. In the past, design concepts have included, Darwin's Galapagos finches.

The selected artist would be required to create a design concept and integrate it into the following applications:

- poster
- large scale billboard
- banner
- various signs for event day, e.g. reserved seating
- print and online newspaper ads
- save the dates
- invitations

- t-shirt
- program
- name cards
- social media and website banner
- slideshow template
- on campus LCD screens

As the design will be implemented at various sizes and resolutions, vector art is preferred.

Please note that the artist will need to be available up until the event day for all aspects of the marketing campaign - from design to print.

Although there is no monetary compensation, this is an opportunity for your artwork to be seen locally and across the country, as Darwin on the Palouse is the premier event for Darwin Day celebrations nationwide.
